Jack Jella reports he has not heard back from the Boys Scouts. The Salinas Area Modelers Club is assisting the boys in earning their aviation merit badges.


Negotiations on the proposed "Core Area" Jet Center have been granted an extension by the City. The Environmental Impact Review was a factor in delays.
